For the control of foxes in natal dens

Cartridges must not be sold separately. Do not destroy box while product still remains.

Net Contents 10 cartridges (240g each)

STORAGE: Store in a closed, original container in a dry, cool, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS: Contents poisonous if swallowed and may irritate the eyes, nose and throat. After ignition this cartridge produces the toxic gas CARBON MONOXIDE. Smoke is poisonous if inhaled and can cause unconsciousness and death. Do not inhale smoke. Once ignited this cartridge will burn VIGOROUSLY until completely spent and is capable of causing severe burns to exposed skin and clothes.

FIRST AID: If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre. Phone Australia 131126. If headache or drowsiness occur, remove victim from contaminated area and give oxygen if available. If unconscious, give artificial respiration and get to a hospital or doctor quickly.
